


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A Game for You and Your 2-Year-Old



INSTRUCTIONS



Explore! Before playing the game, lay out the blocks on the floor and explore them with your child. Five of the blocks depict a room in Bear's house. The largest block shows Bear's backyard.

- Can you stack the blocks? Can you knock them down?
- Can Bear pretend to climb up the block mountain and stand on top?
- Can you nest the blocks, one inside the other?
- How many blocks are there? Let's count them!

Where's Mouse?
Can you find the little mouse on every block? Look closely!

Where's Bear Hiding?

Is Bear in the bedroom? In the playroom? In the kitchen? Take turns hiding and finding Bear.



1. Randomly lay out the blocks on the floor.
2. Hide Bear under one of the blocks.
3. Can your child find Bear?
4. Celebrate finding Bear and then take turns hiding him again and again.

Can You Find It?

On the top panel of each block are pictures of several items. Can your child find each item on the block?

1. Randomly lay out the blocks on the floor.
2. Point to one of the items on the top of a block and ask your child to find it on that block.
3. Can your child find all the items on one block?
4. Ready for more? Choose another block and do it again!

Make a Sequence Work with your child to arrange the boxes in a row in order of size. Start with the smallest block and ask him to help you find the next biggest block. And then the next biggest, and so on.



Tell a Story Use the blocks to create a short story about Bear. Once upon a time there was a little bear who lived in a colorful house . . . Can your child offer details to the story or repeat the story back to you?

Use Many Blocks Expand your child's thinking and problem-solving skills by hiding Bear under more than one block. Start by hiding Bear under two stacked blocks. Does your child easily find Bear? Add more blocks. Does he know to keep lifting up the blocks one by one to find Bear?
